A weighted average is used to determine Grade Point Average (GPA). Quality points are awarded based on performance in each course. The standard course is College Preparatory (CP). There are also Honors (H) and Advanced Placement (AP). Admission to AP and Honors level courses requires the approval of the Department Chair. Grades in Honors Courses and Advanced Placement courses receive additional weight.

Grading

The grading scale is based on 100 points. Grades below 65 are considered failures. Averages are weighted with AP and Honors courses carrying additional quality points.
